# April 10

No quorum from the beginning, the meeting minutes from Mar 6 2025 were not voted.

Welcoming Tanja Obradovic.

- From the beginning of work with EF, was working with Jakarta EE.
- Looking for synergies.

[Thomas] presented the GitLab tracker.

- GitLab tracker was introduced already at the previous meetings.
- As a side note, [Matthew] was impressed by the new Zoom capability to show multiple shared screens on the individual tabs.
- [Thomas] mentioned that not everybody has access to the GitLab tracker, the work to give access is in progress.
  - Matthew and Jonas has access, please refer to them in a case of need.
- Pipeline board at GitLab was presented.
- [Jonas] made some comments:
  - He likes the board, use it, added some issues already.
  - TI case study presentation, one of the items at the board, was discussed.
    - The presentation is very good in general.
    - But PDF is not the format of preference for such presentations.
    - The lead time to publish the presentation was 6 months, which is quite a lot.
    - 1.5 months is the maximum lead time for such a work.
    - Otherwise such information will be distributed using other channels, such as Theia site itself.

■ [Thomas] made a comment that he doesn't know yet why it took so long, he will take a look.

[Olivier Prouvost] was introduced as a community mentor.

- His job is to make onboarding of the new members easier.

We have quorum.

Minutes from Feb 6, 2025 are approved.

Juan gives us a brief overview of the <u>Open Regulatory Compliance Working Group</u>: the <u>Cyber Resilience Act</u> is a major focus.

Juan gives us a brief overview of the <u>Oniro Working Group</u>: adaptation and integration of Open Harmony (Chinese open source project at <u>OpenAtom Foundation</u>) for the European market.

Thomas takes the Program Manager role from John. Thomas shows us his workflow for translating the Eclipse IDE program plan into epics on the respective GitLab project.

Question: is it ok if Thomas uses the same approach for the Cloud DevTools WG?

No objections. Thomas will give us access to a GitLab project.

Matthew says a new working group about Strategic AI is in the making, but there's nothing official yet. There is overlap with our projects, specifically Theia AI and Open Collaboration Tools.

As already voted on last year, the Contributor Award Q1/25 goes to EclipseSource for Theia Al.

Thomas is starting to look into opportunities for outreach. Supporting local meetups could be good, maybe with remote presentations – e.g. in India. Being located in Europe, Thomas can visit events in this area more easily (compared to John earlier).

Jonas announces a press release about Theia Al next Thursday.

### Feb 6

**Tony and Ammar** introduce themselves. Tony worked on debugging in the past and now profiling. Ammar is also currently working in the profiling area and using Trace Compass tools. Located in Austin, Texas.

### Open Invention Network - Frederic Desbiens

Open Invention Network a standalone organization. Protection for patent and open source component registration. Stepping up efforts to defend the open source software.

If the tools can run on Linux then they can be included in the list. Packages submitted are checked by the legal team to see if they can be included. Updated every 18-24 months. Table 13 (revision 13) is closing fast. Eclipse Theia or Che could be added to the list. Companies can also consider joining the OIN.

Jonas: Any argument for submitting all projects in the working group? Frederic: We do not want to flood the OIN with all the Eclipse projects.

Jonas: There are about 7 strategic projects the working group members are using.

Frederic: Then perhaps all 7 makes sense for the Eclipse Cloud Tools Group.

Action: Should have a discussion asynchronously in the meantime. John Kellerman will write a message to the mailing list to start the discussion with projects. ### Steps forward for OpenCollab Server

Eclipse Foundation will be funding it.

However the working group will need to run it.

Miro will take another look at this next quarter.

Some work is ongoing such as updating the website to show the new governance.

Need some clarity before taking steps with deployment, committer access lists and so on.

Some concern over mistakes causing a large cloud bill. Technical measures on the cloud side should avoid this. Tricky when committers could have access to cause errors and high costs.

Transfer will happen soon, we hope.

### Modernization Strategic IG

Not only part of one working group. Joint venture between the Cloud Tools WG and IDE WG. Focus of this is toolchain modernization.

People looking at existing toolchains and deciding what to do next.

Not a migration working group - instead looking at modernization. A way to modernize existing tools built on legacy/older software or look to different web-based technology stacks.

IDE WG is also doing some modernization work in their activity.

Free to join if you are an existing Eclipse member. It is an interest group rather than a working group.



John: We don't have the budget to do this. One or more companies would need to think it is important and sponsor it.

Matthew: These conferences do not seem to be particularly well suited to these WG.

Thomas: What would be a good conference for Theia? Jonas: more likely something in the web arena Matthew: Would like to see a stronger presence within embedded. Members here are building tools for embedded and there are other opportunities.

# Miro: Widening is good. We need to reach more people

Jonas: Theia was super well represented. 12 talks, (2 bofs, 9 theia talks, one sdv theia talk) Marketing was great. Missed opportunity. Theia nor working group not mentioned. Theiacon not mentioned by ef. EF was not aware of Cloud Dev Tools. One talk about theia didn't show theia. Internal communication could be improved.

According to Jonas: Every EF employee should be aware of the events and working groups, as well as projects.

Miro: This is an organizational issue, since the wg didn't participate, as sponsors we have influence there was participation by program managers, but this is indirect influence. The WG should be represented as a sub-organization. Is there a way to have the WG more in the foreground? Can we platform them?

Rob: Venue is nice... but walking 1.6 km to the hotel is problematic.

Konstiantyn: Not enough street lights. Widening the conference is good. Conflicting sessions is a positive. Cross references to other confs. JakartaEE/Theiacon/an overview talk would be good. Very big problems of cross referencing, we need to promote Open-VSX for instance. Core repo of cloud-dev-tools, che is presenting they didn't mention vsx. Theia-Ide could have had more mentions and mention VSX. You need to know about something to be involved in it. Agendas need to be archived and searchable. 404 errors on website. Map of working groups. When there are evening sessions, like bofs there need MORE SANDWICHES. HOW DARE YOU LET ENGINEERS STARVE! WE ARE FAR FROM SANDWICHES.

Neutral infrastructure perhaps implemented for the Theia IDE. Server infrastructure needed for messaging infrastructure.
- Matthew: How much data is used in "try Theia" feature on the website? Limited to 30 mins.
   100-150 sessions per day. Jonas: Thinks the cost is potentially very low due to small data messages.
- Theia Community meeting in March, March 14th 4pm. Anyone interested in an adopter story presentation let Jonas know.
- Action item: Can Jonas provide some sentences to John about this Community meeting so he can post on his blog?
- Prepare for a press release for the Theia IDE and/or the collaboration support. Jonas prefers to split these as they are both important achievements. Jonas will start to prepare these press releases.
- Theia IDE now has an early adopters area so we can test before the main release. Feedback from users is good.
- Matthew: Cross workgroup collaborations engaging with ThreadX group. Are there other

  could suggest new views for the ThreadX team. John is also chasing open hardware and SDV.
- John mentions EclipseCon turning into the OpenCode conference in October. Should be thinking on domain specific Theia oriented projects for each track.
- 2024 Program Plan John runs through the plan. Looking for opportunities to try and engage with adopters that are not part of this working group. Maybe see after the first Community Meeting what happens. Matthew: Should we make meetings customized for different use-cases?
